That's exactly what we need to be doing today because spiritual deception is spreading everywhere.

Concerning the Scriptures, paraphrase versions are loose translations, stay away from them. *The Message* by Eugene Peterson is one of the worst. Also beware of *The Renovare Bible*. If your copy of the scriptures has notes by a preacher, be careful, compare each note with what the scripture says. **God's word is the authority, not the words of any human being.** In your study of God's word, you will come across things that are difficult to understand, continue reading, often times you will find the answer if you continue reading with an honest heart.

Since the Saviour has come, God no more requires anyone to keep the symbolic laws of the Torah. Anyone who desires to keep those symbols (Sabbaths, Kosher, etc.) may do so **but make it clear that those things are not Salvation** but symbols communicating spiritual realities. See Colossians 2:16-17

Clearly, Song of Solomon is **not** of God. It is immoral (pornographic) and idolatrous. See 1Kings 11v1-11
